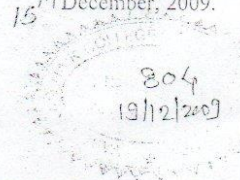

In pursuance of the recommendations made by the Board of college and University Development at its meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2009 vide item No.09, I am to inform you that the report of the local inquiry committee which was accepted by the Board of college and University Development, was placed before the Academic Council at its meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2009 vide item No.3.4 when the council resolved as under :-

"It was resolved that the recommendation made by the BCUD at its meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2009 (vide item No.9) be accepted and that, in accordance therewith, be granted permanent affiliation for the teaching of the courses of study for the B.A and B.Com, degree examination from the academic year 2007-2008 to Vasantnao Naik College of Arts and Commerce, Bakuli Naka, Agardanda Road, Murud-Janjira Dist.Raigad.

Further that the aforesaid affiliation is granted subject to the condition that the college authorities gives an undertaking in writing that they will fulfill the conditions mentioned in the report to the satisfaction of the Academic Council and that the concerned college participated in the examination related work and the teachers involved in the Central Assessment Scheme of the University in both Halves of the examination."

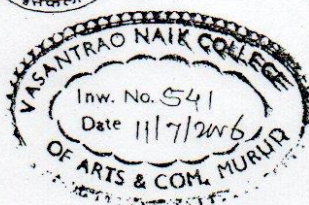

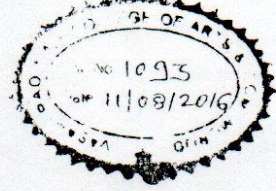

In this connection, I am directed to inform you that your request has been granted and you are permitted to accommodate additional students per division over and above the intake capacity for the following Courses in a division, subject to the following conditions for the academic year 2021-22 only.

Sr. No.	Course Name	Intake	Sanctioned Additional Seats
1	F. Y. B. Com.	120	24
2	F.Y. B.A.	120	24

Increase in number of students should be granted subject to following conditions:

1. The above additional seat allocation is valid only for the academic year mentioned above.
2. The College will strictly adhere to the State Government reservation policy applicable for admission purpose.
3. Number of additional seats are allotted to the College is as per resolved by the Committee OR on the basis of additional seats requested by the College Whichever is less.
4. Colleges are directed to strictly adhere to the admission schedule notified by the University.
5. Admission to the additional seats permitted should be strictly on the merit basis.
6. There shall be no management quota for these additional seats.
7. Colleges cannot claim extra workload for additional allotted seats.
8. The Colleges applying for additional seats are required to have the necessary infrastructure to accommodate these students.
9. In case of autonomous College, the total seats allotted as above are inclusive of the extra seats as per the Circular No.CAD/AFF/ICC/(2021-22)/08/of 2021, dated 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2021.
